Maths—This term our learning will focus predominantly around fractions, decimals and percentages. This will include using taught skills in a range of problem-solving contexts. It is important that the children are practising their tables regularly, in order to support their learning in class. Each week, we will complete a times table square challenge where the children will be encouraged to improve their skills against the clock!

English—Hugo Cabret will be our focus text for writing this term; this is a tale about a young boy who navigates his way through many difficult situations—a story of awe and wonder! We will be covering a number of genres including story writing, newspaper reports and first person narratives

Theme—A lot of our learning across the wider curriculum will focus on the Victorians. We will be learning about inventions which have shaped our lives today and improving our mastery of art techniques through drawing and painting.

Our first Science topic is evolution and adaptation.
