Maths—After a week revisiting fractions, decimals and percentages, our main focus for this term will be applying previously taught skills for all four areas of calculation: addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. Exposing children to these skills in a range of problem-solving contexts continues to be our main focus. We will also cover ratio and proportion, linked to parts of a whole, towards the end of term.

English—We're confident Term 1 won't have passed you by without hearing about our much-loved text, Hugo Cabret! We will be finishing this text with a non-chronological report about film and early cinema. We will then be moving on to focus on formal vocabulary and letter writing.

Theme—Our topic of the 'Vile Victorians' will continue, with a particular focus on crime and punishment as well as Victorian homes and artefacts; we will finish the term by looking at a traditional Victorian Christmas. We will be revisiting our understanding on how light travels in science and learning to use Excel and PowerPoint during our computing sessions.
