

CCH Enrichment Day

In order to mark the end of a very busy term in which our children and you, as parents and carers, have gone above and beyond, we have decided that the last day of term will be a **virtual Enrichment Day**. This day is designed to provide the pupils (and family members) with an opportunity to try something new and experience a slight change of pace from the usual school day! Children attending school will also be involved in enrichment activities although these may differ slightly from the sessions listed below.

We have split the day into sections to try to make this manageable for you as families; *however, apart from the times of the enrichment sessions and Celebration Assembly, this is just a suggestion of how your day could be structured.* The day will begin with a video from Mr Sharda designed to get you mentally and physically prepared for the day; this will be followed by a phonics lesson (EYFS and KS1) and a practical maths activity. The remainder of the day will then be filled with enrichment sessions; **please choose up to 3 activities** from the menu. We would encourage you to complete these as a family in order to avoid issues over device sharing; this will be a great opportunity for you to work with your siblings!
