Music tuition

As from 1st of September 2022, the following policy and conditions will apply:

- 1. Music tuition are for individuals or groups of students provided (dependant on parental/carer request and music tutor availability). Music tuition charges vary from term to term depending on how many pupils take part. As we pass on the costs from the music tuition provider, we split the cost between each pupil.
- 2. The cost for one term of music tuition will be non-refundable and payable in advance and this covers the cost of the lesson and loan of a school instrument (if required).
- 3. A full term's notice must be given when a parent/child wishes to give up lessons.
- 4. Charges cover the cost of the tuition, not the child's attendance. Lessons missed as a result of illness, forgetting instruments, family holidays or any other reason they are absent (excluding school activities), will be charged for.
- 5. Lessons will take place in school time.
- 6. Tuition group sizes vary.
- 7. Children will be offered tuition for one instrument only.
- 8. Damage to instruments, deemed by the music teachers to be caused by negligence or misuse, will be charged for, and may result in a child's tuition being withdrawn, at the discretion of the Headteacher.
- 9. Parents/Carers of children receiving music tuition will be given a copy of this policy to sign and agree to the terms and conditions.
- 10. Where arrears occur, the school will contact parents/carers in writing requesting payment within 2 weeks. Should arrears continue, tuition for the pupil will cease.
