Hanham and Hanham Abbots Parish Councils are working in conjunction with Swift Sports Coaching to run a free football tournament to promote physical well being, exercise and a healthy lifestyle for children living within the local area. There is **no charge** for children to participate as Hanham and Hanham Abbots Parish Councils have very kindly funded the tournament, which includes the use of bibs for teams, medals for the winning team and a trophy for one lucky player of the day.

All children will need to bring shin pads, boots, trainers, suitable outdoor clothing and a pack lunch with a refillable water bottle. The coaches at the tournament have been provided by Swift Sports Coaching, a sports coaching company working with schools throughout South Gloucestershire and Bristol. All coaches are DBS checked, 1st aid qualified and fully insured.

Frequently asked questions-

1. Do you have to stay with your children? **No, you can leave children under the supervision of GCF Coaches.**
2. Is this hard ball or soft ball? **This is soft ball activity.**
3. What do children need to bring? **Appropriately dressed, packed lunch and drink bottle that can be refilled.**
4. Do they need to bring their own equipment? **They can do, we will bring plenty of equipment also so it's not essential.**
5. Can you sign up more than one child? **Yes.**
6. What are the timings? **10am till 4pm**
7. Can you use Childcare Vouchers? **Unfortunately, not, sorry about this.**
8. Why isn't there one closer to me? **We have a big patch to cover so apologies if you don't have a venue closer to where you live.**
9. What happens if it rains? **We are indoors, so it will go ahead no matter the weather.**

All activity will be delivered by Gloucestershire Cricket Foundation members of staff who are:

1. Minimum Level 2 Coaches (most are Level 3)
2. Have ECB DBS enhanced clearance
3. Up to date with Safeguarding Young Cricketers certificate
4. First Aid trained
