Extra-Curricular Clubs- Term 1 and 2

Dear Families,

I am delighted to be able to share our extended extra-curricular clubs offer for the autumn term.

In line with our school vision of Nurture-Grow-Flourish, we want to ensure that our children have the opportunity to experience a wide range of opportunities during their school life; this will enable them to discover new skills and interests and help them to learn more about themselves. As you will see below, we have another fantastic range of clubs on offer this term led by our teaching staff. This is a great opportunity for us to build relationships with different children as well as helping them to see that learning comes in all forms!

We are currently reviewing our enrichment provision as we are aware that some year groups do not have access to an after-school club. If a year group is not provided for this term, we will ensure that they do have provision during the next wave of clubs.

The club offer is presented in the table below but please take note of the following points:

- Choir will run **every week of term**
- All other clubs will run for **6 sessions** starting the week beginning **9 October 2023** and ending during the week beginning **20 November 2023**
- All after school clubs will **finish at 4.30pm** unless indicated otherwise (highlighted in yellow)

If your child would like to take part in one or more of our after school clubs, please sign up via ParentPay. Bookings can be made from **Wednesday 4 October at 4.00pm**. You do not need to book for lunchtime clubs. There is no charge for any of our teacher-led clubs. Should a club be oversubscribed then we will operate a waiting list.

Most of our sports clubs have been selected due to there being upcoming competitions against other schools; every child attending one of the clubs will be provided with an **opportunity to represent CCH** should there be a competition or tournament planned.
