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RSHE Learning

Attached with this bulletin, you will find a letter from Miss Stone regarding our relationships, sex and health education learning which takes place during term six. RSHE is a statutory part of the curriculum for all children; in the summer term, the focus is on enabling them to learn about their bodies and how these change as they grow older. Anything which is classified as human reproduction (applies only to Years 4, 5 and 6) is non-statutory but recommended in order to equip our children with the knowledge and understanding they need in an age-appropriate manner. However, parents/ carers do have the right to withdraw their child from the human reproduction content (marked in red in the attached letter). If you feel this is something you need to consider, please contact the school where a member of the leadership team will discuss any concerns or questions you may have.

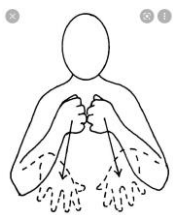
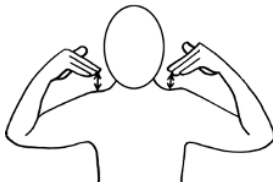
Last day of term- early finish

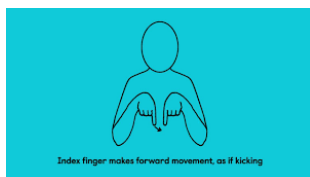
