Monday 19th May will mark the start of our CCH Sports' Week. This has been designed for two primary reasons: firstly, to promote the importance of active lifestyles and exercise for our pupils and, secondly, to provide them with opportunities to learn and develop outside of the classroom, utilising skills of teamwork, perseverance and resilience as they tackle new challenges.

Our theme this year will be the **'Women's Euros 2025'**. Throughout the week, children will try new sports, take part in some friendly competition and meet some athletes. We hope this will inspire all pupils.

The shop is a chance for families to get their own skipping rope as well as other merchandise such as: headbands, suits, water bottles and keyrings.



Active Travel

Throughout the week, classes will be taking part in active travel challenges with prizes from the WOW travel tracker that we use daily. We will also be running the Golden Lock Initiative. Each day, a bike and a scooter will be locked. At the end of the day, a member of staff will unlock the bike and scooter with the owner and the owner will be given a prize. We hope this will encourage children to actively travel to school.

Sports' Day

We are delighted to welcome you all back to spectate the EYFS/KS1 Sports' Day **9.30am-11.30am** and KS2 Sports' Day **1.10pm-3.20pm** on **Wednesday 21st May 2025**. Children will take part in a variety of carousel activities showcasing skills they have learned, as well as competitive races such as the sprint and relay. Children have been allocated their new 'house team' names. The children voted to have Bristol transport as the overarching themes for our teams. The children will stay in these houses throughout their school career. Children will be competing against other teams in a numbered group. They will be given a label with their team and number to wear on their PE t-shirt. Results will be announced during our Friday Celebration Assembly.

Important information

- The entrance and exit to Sports' Day will **only** be through the **main double green gates at the front of the school** this year. The gate will be **closed 10 minutes** after the start of each Sports' Day. You may leave for emergencies, but there will be **no exiting/re-entry** throughout the morning or afternoon sessions as all of our staff will have a role in supporting our pupils during Sports' Day. **There will be no entry/ exit from the Barton entrance at any time.**
- Only some sections of the field will be sectioned off with tape so please respect our athletes by spectating from a suitable distance.
- **Please do not park** around the Barton gate area this year or use our school car park. There are plenty of roads available near school that do not block house entry or exit. Last year, we had a few unhappy residents who could not go about their daily business as they were blocked in – **please park considerably at all times should you need to drive to school.**
- There will be a **shaded seated area** by the big tree at the back of the field.
- **Accessible toilets** are available through the Year 3/4 entrance. Athletes will have access to other toilets.
- **When families leave after each Sports' Day, please allow staff to support the children away from the field. KS2 pick up will be as usual from their classrooms.**
- The Friends of CCH have kindly offered to run a **refreshment stand**. This is labelled on our map. The refreshments and snacks are **only for spectators**, **please do not pass children these throughout the day.** Children will receive an ice lolly at the end of their events from the friends- thank you!

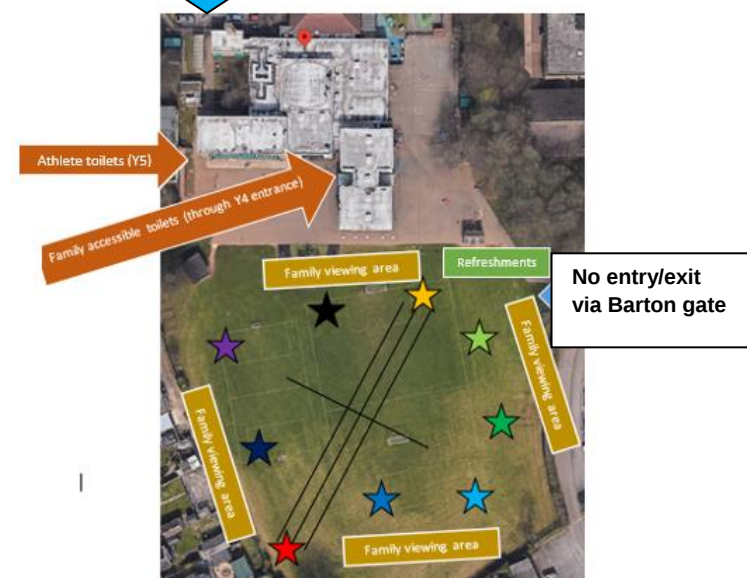


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KS1 Map

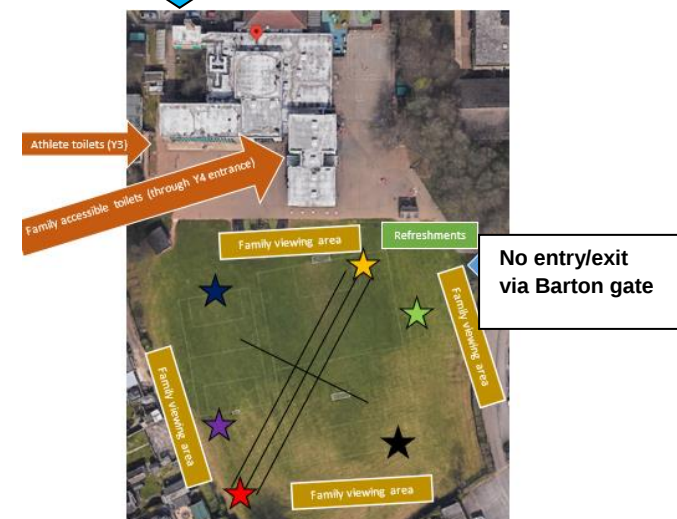
